





STEAM TRAIN EVENT

ENNISCORTHY ROCKIN' FOOD

We are delighted to have the Steam Train Loco no. 4 paying a visit to Enniscorthy on Sunday 6th August.

Loco no. 4 was built in 1947 and acquired by the RPSI (Rail Preservations Society of Ireland) in the early 1970's. Most of its working life was spent working north of the border and it is the RPSI youngest locomotive, the oldest is dated 1879.

The carriages were built by Cravens of Sheffield in the early 1960s and acquired by the RPSI in 2006. They were painted in a Blue and Cream livery by the Society and the interiors redone with new upholstery. A lot of work has gone into the maintenance to bring them back to mainline running.

Train departs Connolly Station 10.30. Arrives Enniscorthy 13.20. Departs Enniscorthy for Wexford Town 13.30. Arrives Wexford Town 14.00. Departs Wexford Town 16.40. Arrives Enniscorthy 16.40. Departs Enniscorthy 16.55.


